Why ?

I believe that diabolists can write their tricks down as all the other jugglers, and share them.

For that reason I am developing a siteswap system for diabolists that doesn't exclude the other juggling props notation.

In this research I discovered that we can do diabolo in more states than only high or low, and go from one state to another.

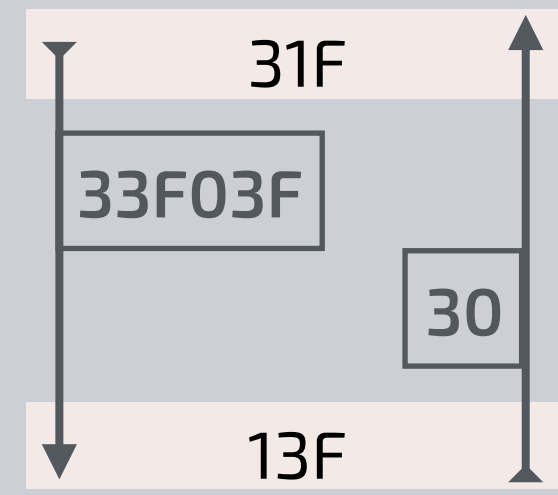
I hope it will help you to improve your technique and understand better the patterns that you do. You can also practice rhythms and heights with less diabolos and later work with more.

How does it work?

The numbers work like in regular siteswap but we put an F after the number if the throw goes by the string.*

3 Diabolos Low = 33F [a 3 by the air and 3F by the rope]

States transitions:



Here we have two patterns of two diabolos in different states, 31 and 13. We can see the transitions to go from one pattern to the other, 33F03F and 30.

31F 31F 31F ⇒ 33F03F ⇒ 13F 13F 13F
 13F 13F 13F ⇒ 30 ⇒ 31F 31F 31F

Don't forget... all the transitions also work like tricks!!!!

*F- FORCE
 We use F for the objects that we throw by the string, it's a Forced Bounce Throw

Are there more transitions?

Yes, I tried to put the transitions that respect most the natural diabolo movement. I never put a parallel throw and I tried to respect that one hand always throw to the air and the other to the string.

Why I didn't search all the transitions?

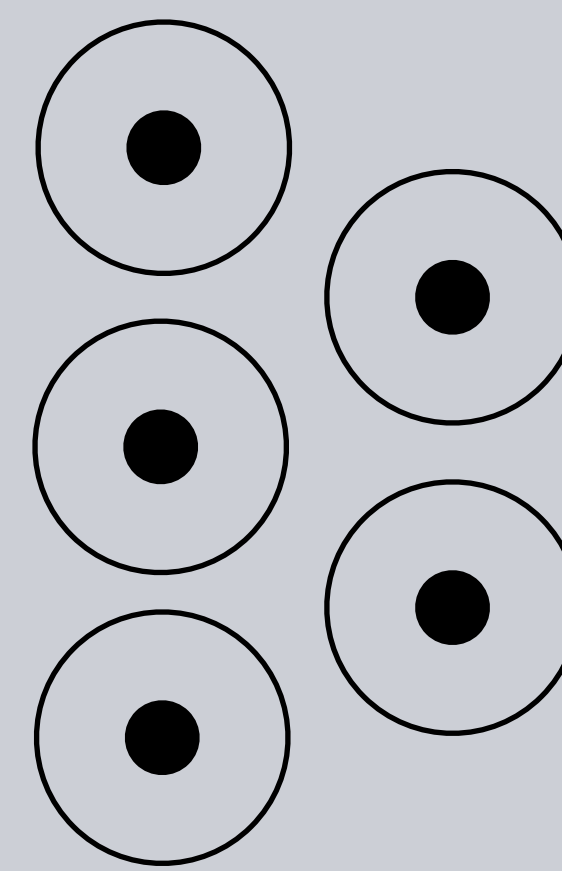
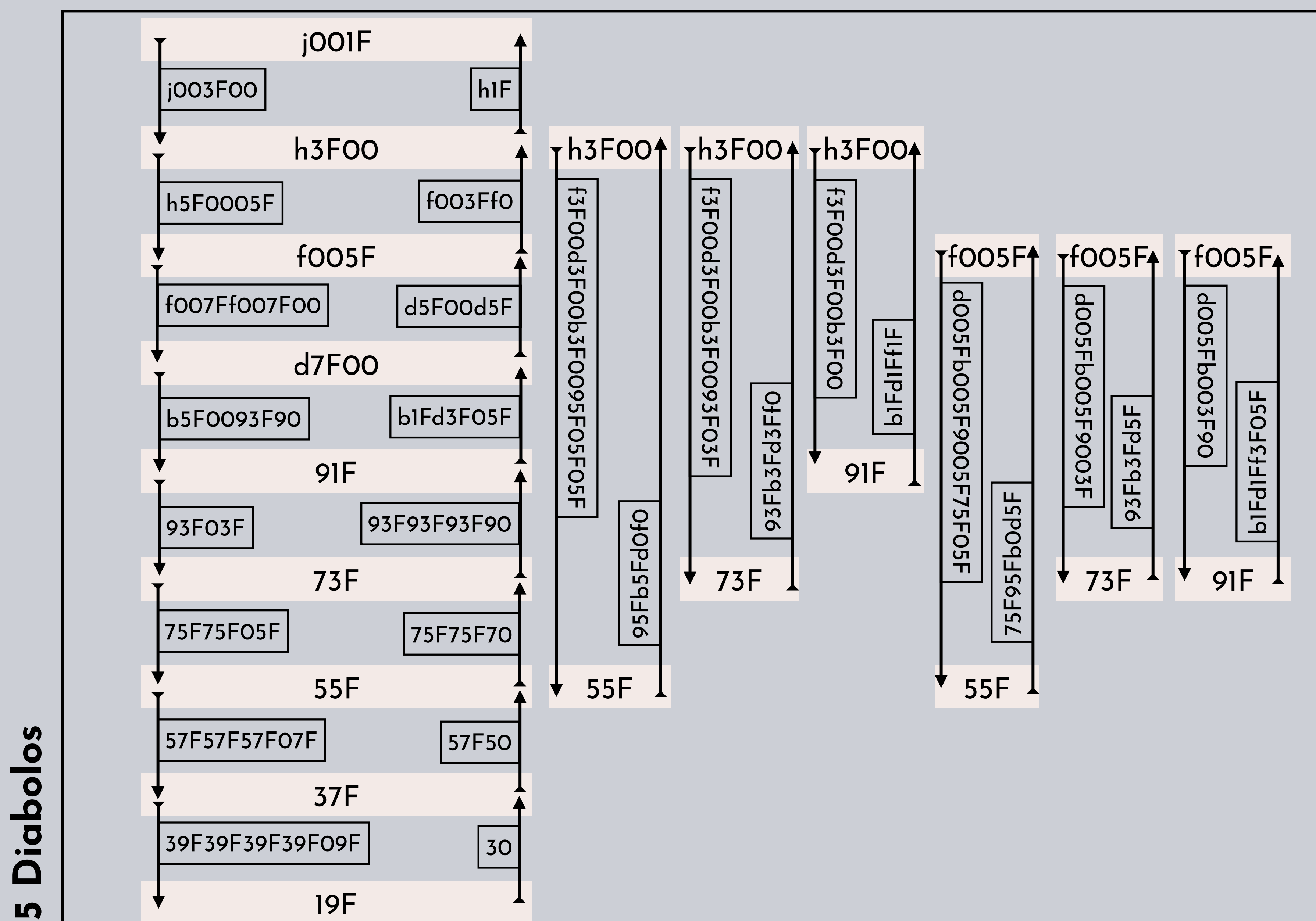
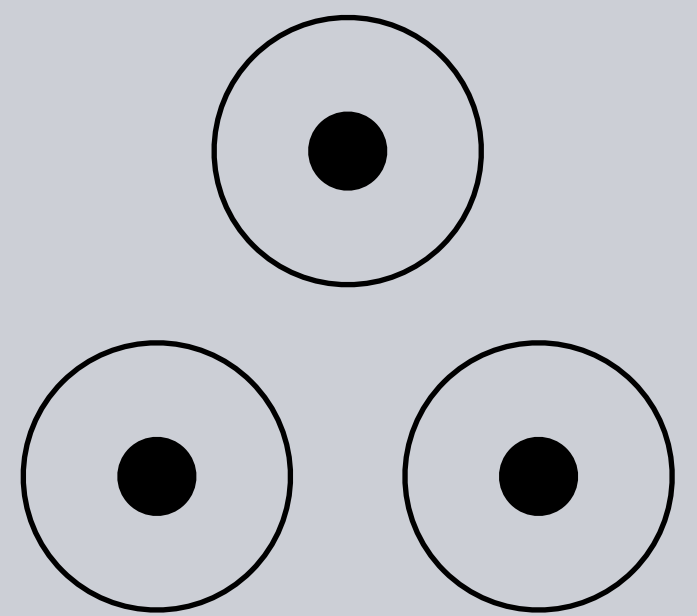
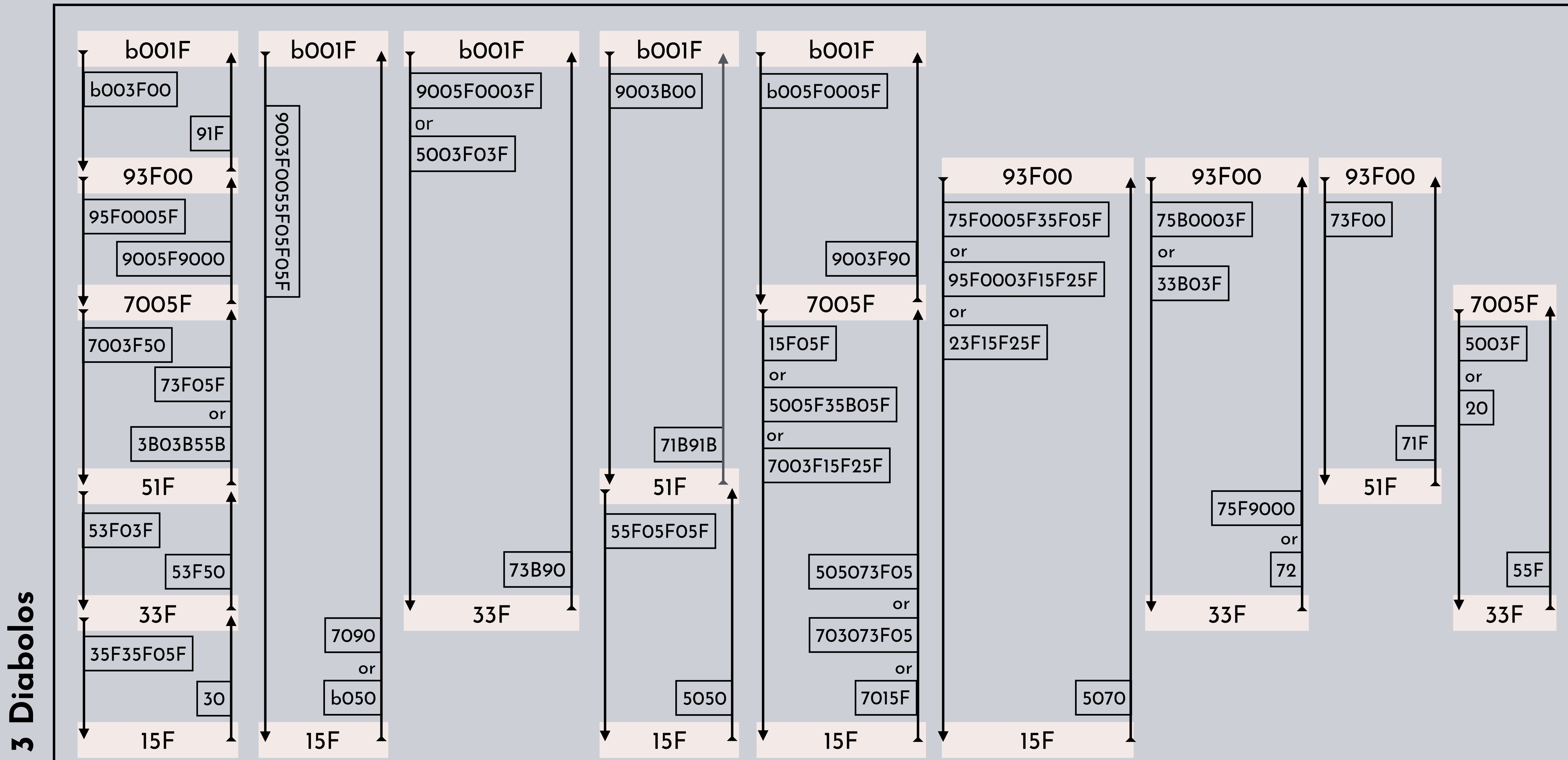
I decided to do only the stairs and some "obvious" patterns, that maybe are the most useful, but if you want some specific transition or some specific siteswap like 3up, 4up or 5up, 3up to "low" etc... tell me.
